

SHREVE ROAD SHARED USE PATH HAYCOCK ROAD & ROUTE 7 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS




Location and Limits of the Projects



Purpose of the project

- Connects W Broad Street (Route 7)
 to the Washington & Old Dominion (W&OD)
 Trail
- Addresses safety needs
- A new multiuse path to better connect the W&OD Trail to the West Falls Church Metro Station




Shreve Rd. median looking south



- The concept design displayed or presented are not final design plans
- Construction of 10' Shared Use Path/sidewalk, 1300' long, along the east side of Shreve Road
- Installation of new crosswalks at Gordon Road intersection
- Construction of 6' refuge island, at Route 7 intersection
- ADA compliant curb ramps
- Additional land rights for utility impacts or any other impacts may be required as the design progresses

- Connecting the proposed shared use path to the W&OD Trail
- Modified, shortened, pedestrian crossing at the Virginia Concrete Company
- ADA compliant curb ramps
- 10' wide asphalt shared use path
- Crosswalk at Gordons Road
 Intersection






- 10' wide concrete sidewalk

- Lane reconfiguration


- Curb bump out



Utility pole relocation at the northeast corner of Gordons Rd. intersection




Retaining wall construction in front of GORDON'S ADDITION property



Purpose of the project

- Connect to the proposed Shreve Road shared use path on northbound Haycock Road from Route 7 intersection to Mustang Alley
- Curb-separated shared use path extension along northbound Haycock Road from W Broad Street/Route 7 to Mustang Alley to provide direct school access
- Lane reconfiguration



Existing Conditions Near Route 7 Intersection




Haycock Rd. and Route 7 intersection looking north – Google Earth Image





Haycock Rd. north bound looking south toward Route 7 intersection





- New 10' wide asphalt SUP and concrete sidewalk
- In-kind brick area replacement
- Lane reconfiguration
- ADA compliant curb ramps





Projects Schedule

- Design and construction of both the projects will be completed simultaneously
- Projects schedule is subject to change as design progresses
- No land acquisition is anticipated for Haycock Road & Route 7 Intersection Improvements project based on the concept design

Schedule

- 60% Design Winter 2025
- 90% Design Summer 2026
- Land Acquisition Winter/Spring 2027 to Fall 2027
- Utility Relocation Fall 2027 to Spring 2028
- Construction Begin Spring 2028
- Construction Completion Fall/Winter 2029
