Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)

BRT is an enhanced bus service. It operates much like rail service, with dedicated lanes, but with the flexibility and lower cost of bus vehicles. Fairfax County Department of Transportation (FCDOT) is implementing a bus rapid transit system along North Kings Highway and Richmond Highway from Huntington Metrorail Station to Fort Belvoir.
