## Fairfax County Transportation Advisory Commission (TAC)

Whereas, Fairfax County has made it a priority to encourage and enable increased walking and biking among its citizens, and;

**Whereas,** the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors (BOS) directed the Fairfax County Department of Transportation (FCDOT) to initiate the ActiveFairfax project to achieve the above goals, and;

Whereas, the BOS has provided special funding for Phase I to define the vision and goals and describe the safety considerations for the Active Fairfax project, and;

Whereas, FCDOT has identified additional work that will need to be accomplished in Phase II to develop an implementation plan for the ActiveFairfax project,

## Therefore be it resolved,

- The TAC commends FCDOT for the quality of the work it has prepared for the Phase I presentation to the BOS Transportation Committee on May 25, 2021, and;
- The TAC agrees with FCDOT that Phase II should address the areas of Need and Demand, Safety, Education, Economic Impacts, Implementation Guidance, and Funding Prioritization, and;
- The TAC encourages the BOS to continue its support for the ActiveFairfax project, to include the Phase II effort beginning in the fall of 2021.
