Phase 1

- VDOT Punch List
 - ➤ Old Meadow Road realignment complete
 - > Dulles Connector Road (DCR) Shoulder Repairs
 - Design approved by VDOT and work to be completed in 2022.
 - ➤ Remaining Manhole/Structure Repairs
 - Remaining work is expected to be completed in Spring 2022.
- Phase 1 Close out \$2.982B (no change)

- Overall Phase 2 100% complete
- Budget



Fare Card Machine Installation




Current Activities – Operational Readiness Testing



	Activities	Completion/Duration
Operational Readiness Testing	 WMATA conducts operational tests, simulated service, etc. MWAA and contractor continue completion of punchlist. 	 No fixed duration Contingent upon WMATA testing and completed when WMATA declares Operational Readiness.
Pre-Revenue Activities	 WMATA asset inventory, warranty management, document transfer, staff and first responder familiarization, final documents, policy and procedure updates, final station mobilization, etc. 	 Approximately 90 days Ends with the start of revenue service

Current Activities – Continued

- Metro Operational Readiness Testing to be Completed:
 - Package A 70% completed
 - Package B 63% completed
- Safety and Security Certification Process is ongoing
- MWAA and contractor on punchlists for Package A and B is ongoing
 - 1 issue 'Unresolved' Heat Tape Deficiency (newly identified)
- Additional Activities not Related to Operational Readiness
 - Installation of sidewalk on Sunrise Valley near Reston Parkway expected spring 2022



Simulated service along Phase 2




Sidewalk Utility Location

Fairfax County Activities

- Fairfax County punchlist verification ongoing
- Maintenance and Operations Agreement, Land Conveyance
 - Similar to Phase 1 agreement
 - Fairfax retains ownership of Kiss and Rides
 - WMATA ownership of tracks, station pedestrian bridges, traction power substations, and tiebreaker stations; easements around entrance pavilions.


STATION PYLON'

Fairfax County Activities - Continued

- Herndon Station Garage Completed April 2019
 - Bus loop repaving was completed in July 2020.
- Innovation Center Station Garage Completed June 2020
 - One-year warranty items are nearing completion by the contractor.
- Non-Residential Use Permit coordination with Dept. of Planning and Development
- WMATA Parking Agreement Complete
