

  - Provide design guidance on safety/comfort in active transportation
  - Provide policy and program recommendations to support **implementation** & **performance measures**








### ActiveFairfax Project Background

- Funding received for Phase I in 2019
- Funding received for Phase II in 2021
- Alta Planning + Design and AECOM consultants
- Estimated **Project Duration**:
  - Phase I: Summer 2020 Winter 2022
  - Phase II: Winter 2022 Fall 2023








# ActiveFairfax Project Milestones



The Board and the public will have frequent input on the milestones in Phase II



In January 2020, the Board of Supervisors passed a motion to make Fairfax County safer for pedestrians and bicyclists.

As part of the ActiveFairfax Transportation Plan effort Fairfax County DOT developed draft recommendations for a countywide Safe Streets for All Program, which will become a stand-alone initiative once approved.

# Draft Safe Streets for All Program: Board Transp Comm Feedback

- **Draft recommendations** were presented to Board Transportation Committee on June 29, 2021:
  - Suggested additional recommendations:
    - Branding and communication strategy
    - Context-sensitive approach to street design
    - User-friendly crash data dashboard
    - Active transportation facility usage data collection
    - Indication of cost
  - Concerns: VDOT buy-in; cost of new infrastructure; limited available funding

# Draft Safe Streets for All Program: Community Engagement

- Community engagement November December 2021
  - Four small group discussions with
     Opportunity Neighborhood residents
  - Two public information meetings
  - One round table with community organizations
  - Online feedback
- Received positive feedback and support
- General sense of urgency to address safety concerns





# Draft Safe Streets for All Program: Community Feedback


#### **General support** for:

- Lowering speeds
- Safer intersections and mid-block crossings
- Better connectivity
- Prioritization of areas w/ highest need
- Street lighting
- Road safety **performance measures** and targets

#### Key Concerns:

- VDOT Buy-In
- Local and State Policy Changes
- Cost of Improvements & Availability of Funding
- Length of Implementation Timeframes





Draft Safe Streets for All Program: Next Steps

- Finalize recommendations
- Return March 1 with a phased implementation strategy to secure the Board's input
- Board action in spring 2022
