Key Project Goals

- Reconcile the Bicycle Master Plan, Countywide Trails Plan and regional connectivity in Area Plans
- Identify and address missing links in the active transportation network and improve safety and access to activity centers, schools, parks and transit (first mile/last mile)
- Bring the planned bicycle and trails network recommendations up to current standards
- Provide countywide guidance on pedestrian and bicycle safety and comfort, including holistic street design
- Reinforce active transportation as a key element to placemaking
- Provide guidance for context sensitive street and trail design
- Develop effective ActiveFairfax Transportation Plan communications strategy

ActiveFairfax Transportation Plan

Key Project Goals (Cont'd)

- Develop an ActiveFairfax Transportation Facility Selection Toolkit
- Provide implementation, policy and active transportation program recommendations and guidance
- Engage the community and other stakeholders throughout the ActiveFairfax Transportation Plan update
- Develop input and guidance for updating the County's Comprehensive Plan
- Develop input and guidance for updating the County's Public Facility Manual and Fairfax County Code
- Ensure pedestrian and bicycle facilities connect to Transit Development Plan and Network Study transit stations
- Coordinate with neighboring jurisdictions

Outreach activities may include but are not limited to:

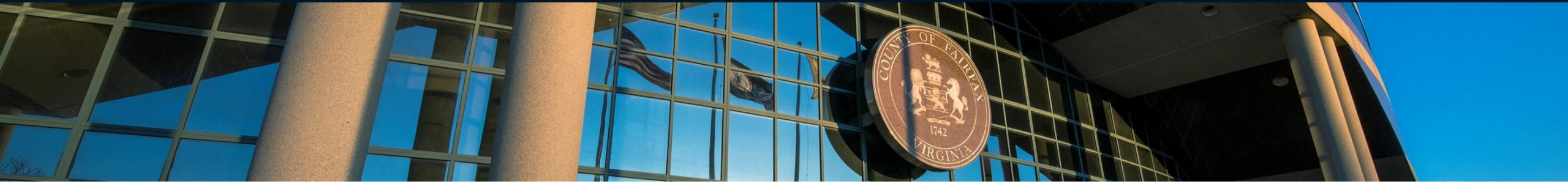
- Community surveys and focus groups.

- Pop-up events, street interviews, bike tours and walk audits.
- Community forums, open houses and public hearings.
- Cross-promotional efforts through community and partner agency engagement.
- Traditional media outreach and advertising
- Other – Board suggestions

ActiveFairfax Transportation Plan Proposed Timeline of Tasks

- Spring 2020: Hire Consultant
- Summer/Fall 2020:
 - Assessment of current conditions and regional travel patterns
 - Audit of local and state policies
 - Community engagement
- Winter 2020/Spring 2021:
 - Update/development of goals and objectives, conceptual countywide active transportation system and systematic safety action plan
 - Community engagement
 - Board of Supervisors interim endorsement of active transportation goals, objectives and planning framework

ActiveFairfax Transportation Plan Proposed Timeline of Tasks (con'd)

- Summer/Fall 2021:
 - Update/development of active transportation network recommendations, proposed comp plan text amendments, active transportation priorities plan, and technical program guidance
 - Community engagement
- Fall 2021/Winter 2022:
 - Public Hearings
 - Board of Supervisors adoption of ActiveFairfax Transportation Plan
