NEPA environmental documentation and 30% design processes have been separated. The 30% design was completed in fall 2020 and NEPA documentation is anticipated to be complete in spring 2021. Virtual community meetings were held on 1/27/21 and 1/28/21 to present options for branding the Richmond Highway BRT system. Various brands and logos that have been developed through focus groups and other community input were presented. Survey for public feedback is ongoing until 2/19/21.
