








Study Background


- Results of 2014 traffic analysis led to selection of a concept with:
 - A ring road
 - Four-way intersection
 - Route 50 widening
 - Shifted ramps to and from Route 50
 - Willston / Village Center to Route 7
 - Additional connecting streets







Typical Conditions Recap: PM Travel Patterns














2030 Phasing: Scenario 1




- Ring Road along the west side of the interchange
- Ring Road will be four lanes with a center turn lane/median
- Includes cycle track and sidewalks
- Hillwood Avenue connection adjusted
- Slightly adjusted ramps to/from Route 50 on west








2030 Phasing: Scenario 2



Extend Ring Road across Route 50 in the southeast


- New segment will include exclusive bus facilities
- New location for Transit Center
- Access Road intersects Ring Road
- New and adjusted ramps to/from Route 50 on east







2030 Transit Considerations



- Transit Center along Access Road
- Buses will access the transit center from the interchange
- Transit Center retains similar capacity
- Buses circulate back to Route 7 along the Ring Road






2030 PM Vehicle Travel Times








2030 PM Baseline Levels of Service (LOS)






















2030 Pedestrian Crossing Times




